13 March 2023 FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE Preliminary work continues on new Snake River Bridge and WYO 22 and WYO 390 intersection

Jackson, Wyo. – The Wyoming Department of Transportation and contract crews from Ames Construction, Inc., are still conducting gravel extraction and clearing trees as the replacement of the Snake River Bridge continues.

WYDOT and Ames will not be working in the riverbed past March 15, due to restrictions. WYDOT plans to begin work on the Green Lane underpass in the next month, and the contractor will be working towards completing the underpass by mid-July.

Drivers will see minimal impacts to traffic for this work. Crews will do their best to accommodate the flow of traffic, but those traveling through the area are advised to watch for flaggers and trucks entering and exiting construction areas.

"We are planning on maintaining two lanes of travel—one in each direction for the duration of the project," resident engineer Bob Hammond said.

The work is part of the Snake River Bridge and Intersection project, which was awarded in November of 2022. The work includes the replacement of the Snake River Bridge on WYO 22, the reconstruction of the intersection of WYO 22 and WYO 390, wildlife crossings and other work on approximately 1.80 miles of WYO 22 & WYO 390 in Teton County.
